



## Bee & Wasp Danger Signs

Live or dead insects.

- Nests — under the eaves, in lofts, in bushes or trees, etc.
- Noise — constant buzzing or humming

## Steps to Take

- Proof your premises with insect screens and doors.
- By mid summer, wasp nests can reach considerable size. Some nests can be the size of basketballs or even larger! Common sites for a wasp nests include under the roof eaves, behind shutters or in sheds.
- This risk from these insects increases towards the end of summer – it is preferable to destroy wasp and nests earlier in the year before wasps become aggressive
